

## **Lake Barcroft WID Seeks New Trustee**

Tony Bracken, one of the three Trustees of the Lake Barcroft Watershed Improvement District (WID), will resign his position after seven years of service to the community. To assist in choosing his successor, the WID and the LBA Board have formed a joint Nominating Committee composed of the two continuing Trustees, Charles de Seve (Chair) and Pete Silvia, and two members of the LBA Board, Dave Goslin and Bill Herz. Expressions of interest in being nominated to fill this vacancy for trustee (who will act as treasurer) and/or suggestions of qualified candidates are sought from all members of the community.

A governmental body with taxing power, the WID is responsible for maintaining and operating the Lake Barcroft Dam and maintaining the quality of the Lake. It functions with an annual operating and capital budget of approximately \$ 1,000,000 and a full time paid staff of four plus part time workers.
